GOALS

PURPOSE

Our program is a ministry of Redeemer Lutheran Church. We offer age-appropriate classes for children six weeks old through five years old. We offer full day and half day programs to meet the needs in our community.

PHILOSOPHY

As a developmental philosophy-based program, we emphasize interrelated areas which are important for the growth of the whole child: intellectual, social, physical, spiritual, emotional and creative. Emphasis is placed on meeting the needs of the individual child in a group setting. Every child is helped to experience success and positive feelings of self-worth at his/her level of maturity. A love of learning is fostered through a Christian environment rich in opportunities for growth. Children's natural curiosity is encouraged as they investigate, discover, and solve problems in their daily experiences.
